RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J.(Oral)

This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.15 dated 25.2.2010 under Sections 448, 452, 511, 427, 148, 149, 120-B, 406 IPC registered at PS Mehatpur, District Jalandhar.

Contentends that the petitioner was regular in appearance before the trial court in case FIR No.15 dated 25.2.2010 under aforesaid sections.

Due to mistake in noting a Court date, the petitioner failed to appear on 25.3.2015 which has resulted in issuance of arrest warrants.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr.Ankur Jain, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

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The State can have no objection in such a matter as the purpose of the arrest warrants was to secure the presence of the petitioner in Court which he undertakes before this Court to appear on the next date of hearing fixed before the learned trial Court.

Since non-appearance was an isolated incident occurring for the first time the operation of the arrest warrants dated 25.3.2015 shall remain stayed till such time as the petitioner appears in the trial Court and submits his bail bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court in terms of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

With these direction, the petition stands disposed of.
