Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation on 13.6.2015 after passing of the order on the last date and, thereafter, he did not receive any information from the Investigating Officer and he was not joined in the investigation.

State Counsel has, however, shown the record produced by ASI Satinder Kumar, which shows that notice was issued to the petitioner on 24.6.2015 to be present for investigation on 25.6.2015. The said notice was received by the petitioner who signed the same by putting the date as 24.6.2015 and also his mobile number. However, he did not appear on 25.6.2015 which fact stands admitted by his counsel as according to his information, the petitioner was not called after 13.6.2015.

In view of the fact that the petitioner had not joined the investigation even after receiving the notice, the petition is dismissed.
