Prayer in this petition, filed under Section 438, Cr.P.C., is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, Jagdish Kumar @ Pappu, son of Sultan, resident of Surinder Kulchianwali Gali, Gwal Mandi, Police Station, Cantonment, Amritsar, who has been booked for having committed the offences punishable under Sections 323, 324, 326 and 506 read with Section 34, IPC, in a case arising out of FIR No. 46, dated 18.2.2015, registered at Police Station, Sultanwind, Amritsar City, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the State on instructions from

ASI Parveen Kumar of Police Station, Sultanwind, Amritsar City, District Amritsar, submits that in compliance of the interim directions dated 4.6.2015, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and perusing the material available on record, the present petition is allowed. The interim directions issued vide order dated 4.6.2015, are made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when required to do so and abide by all the conditions laid down under Section 438(2), Cr.PC.
