RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK, J. (Oral)

Petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in FIR No.24 dated 19.4.2012 registered under Sections 399 and 402 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25, 54 (54) and 59 of the Arms Act, at Police Station, Dhanaula, District Barnala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after having been granted bail by this Court, petitioner has been regularly appearing on each and every date fixed before the learned trial Court. However, when the case was listed for hearing before the learned trial Court on 19.5.2015, petitioner could not appear as he was unwell. This was the reason that the learned trial Court has issued warrants of arrest for 11.6.2015. He further submits that petitioner is ready and willing to surrender before the learned court who may be directed to consider the bail application of the petitioner keeping in view the above-said totality of facts and circumstances of the case.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and without

commenting anything on merits, lest it should prejudice the rights of either of the parties, petitioner is directed to surrender before the learned trial Court on the date already fixed, i.e. 11.6.2015 by moving an appropriate application for bail. Petitioner shall also be at liberty to bring all the attending circumstances to the notice of the learned trial Court while seeking bail. The learned trial Court is directed to consider the bail application of the petitioner on the basis of all the attending circumstances brought to its notice by the petitioner and decide the same at an early date by passing an appropriate thereon, strictly in accordance with law.

With the above-said observations made and directions issued, the present petition stands disposed of.
