Counsel for the petitioner has placed reliance upon the order dated 04.05.2015 (Annexure P-1) passed by this Court in Criminal Revision No.1384 of 2015 (Harmandeep Singh @ Harman Vs. State of Punjab), whereby the revision petition was allowed and the petitioners therein, who are co-accused of the petitioner in the same FIR, have been granted the benefit of Section 167(2) Cr.P.C. and given the concession of bail. Reference has also been made to the order dated 06.05.2013 (Annexure P-2) passed by this Court in Criminal Misc. M No.13997 of 2015 (Jatinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab), where again the co-accused was granted the benefit of bail as per the provisions contained under Section 167 (2) Cr.P.C.

Counsel for the respondent states that till date the challan could not be presented because of non-receipt of F.S.L report.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed.

Petitioner is granted the concession of bail under Section 167 (2) Cr.P.C. He shall be released on bail subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety to the satisfaction of Special Judge/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Tarn Taran.
