The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 of the Criminal Procedure Code, 1973 for the quashing of the FIR No.53, dated 30.03.2014, under Sections 323, 324 and 326 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Bawa Khel, District Jalandhar, along with all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

After recording the statements of complainant Vikash Jha and accused Umesh Sharma @ Bawa, learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Jalandhar has reported to this Court that the parties have entered into a compromise and that the same is genuine, voluntarily and without any undue influence and coercion.

Since the parties have amicably settled their dispute, therefore, the FIR in question along with all the consequential proceedings stands quashed.

Petition is accordingly allowed.
