Petitioner, by way of instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeks direction against the learned Judge, Special Court, Ludhiana to issue release warrants of the petitioner, after accepting his bail bonds in FIR No.160 dated 23.11.2012 under Sections 15, 25, 29, 61, 85 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Dehlon, District Ludhiana.

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Jarnail Singh, Police Station Dehlon, Ludhiana, submits that since during pendency of the present petition, petitioner has been convicted in this very FIR No.160 dated 23.11.2012 by the learned Judge, Special Court, Ludhiana vide judgment of conviction dated 16.09.2015, present petition does not survive and the same may be disposed of, as such.
