The petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.394 dated 18.12.2012 registered under Sections 363, 366-A and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station City Taran Tarn, on the basis of compromise.

The FIR was registered at the instance of Darshan Kaur-respondent No.2 mother of the prosecutrix alleging that her daughter Manpreet Kaur had been kidnapped by the petitioners with an intention to marry her with petitioner No.1.

A perusal of the file indicates that the affected person has not been impleaded as a party.

State counsel informs that challen has already been presented and charges were framed on 20.03.2014 and one witness has already been examined.

Counsel for the respondent No.2 informs that her daughter is married to the petitioner No.1 and the said relationship has been accepted.

In view of the said circumstances, this petition is disposed of with the direction to the trial Court to record the statement of the prosecutrix within the period of two months after the next date of hearing and in case she does not appear, it will be open to the trial Court to pass acquittal order in favour of the petitioners.
