FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

Report dated 17.11.2015 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class Kurukshetra has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioner Dinesh Kumar as well as of complainant Narender Kumar it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that it is a pure accidental death case and that the parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.51 dated 06.03.2009 under Sections 279, 337 and 304-A IPC at Police Station Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra and all other consequential

proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioner.

Petition stands disposed off.
