This is a petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.07 dated 15.05.2015, registered under Sections 420/467/468/471 and 120-B of IPC along with Section 13(1)(D) read with Section 13(2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, at Police Station Vigilance Bureau, Bathinda Range, Bathinda.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

This Court, while issuing notice of motion on 05.06.2015, directed that in the event of arrest, the petitioner would be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer in connection with abovesaid case FIR.

Learned State counsel stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for interrogation.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, the order dated 05.06.2015 passed by this Court is made absolute.
