Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.99 dated 25.04.2014, under Sections 147, 452, 506, 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 3/4 of Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe, 1989, registered at Police Station Sadar Dabwali, District Sirsa.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 29.05.2014:-

“Counsel would inter alia contend that the allegations in the F.I.R are totally false and motivated. Towards such assertion counsel would submit that the complainant in the present case i.e. Hanuman was an accused in an F.I.R lodged prior in point of time i.e. on 14.2.2014 at the behest of the petitioner. That apart, counsel would contend that the offence under Section 3 of the S.C./S.T Act, 1989 would not be made out

inasmuch as even as per the version of the complainant the alleged remarks were not made in the domain of the public view.

Notice of motion, returnable for 30.7.2014.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and he shall remain bound by the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Assistant Sub Inspector Naresh Kumar has submitted that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted by this Court to the petitioners vide order dated 29.05.2014, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
