MAHESH GROVER, J.

The petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in terms of Section 438 Cr.P.C in case FIR no. 70 dated 19.4.2015 registered under sections 61,1,14 of Excise Act at Police Station Laddowal Ludhiana.

This Court on 5.6.2015 granted interim protection to the petitioner from whom some illicit liquor was recovered.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has since joined investigation to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer , which fact is not controverted by the learned State counsel on instructions from SI Swaran Singh.

Thus, without commenting upon the merits of the case but noticing the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer, instant petition is accepted. Interim directions dated 5.6.2015 are hereby made absolute, however subject to the condition that the petitioner continues to comply with the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
