Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.112 dated 09.05.2015, registered at Police Station City Sangrur, District Sangrur, under Section 15 of the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act (hereinreferred as 'the Act').

Notice of motion was issued.

Today, learned State counsel has appeared on behalf of respondent and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

As per prosecution version, 6 kgs. poppy husk was recovered which the petitioner has thrown and fled away from the spot. In pursuance of the order dated 01.07.2015, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation. She is not required for custodial interrogation. No useful purpose will be served by

sending the petitioner to custody.

Therefore, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and without discussing the merits of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merit of the case, the present petition is accepted and the interim order dated 01.07.2015, passed by this Court, granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.
