Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, Raj Kumar Gupta, son of Chhatrapal Gupta, resident of F-210, Pandav Nagar, Delhi-91, who has been booked for having committed the offences punishable under Sections 406 and 420, IPC, in a case arising out of FIR No. 50, dated 28.4.2015, registered at Police Station, Sirhind, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

Learned counsel contends that in compliance of the interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 5.6.2015, the petitioner did join the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

Gurmeet Singh of Police Station, Sirhind, District Fatehgarh Sahib, very fairly concedes that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of above, the present petition is allowed. The interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 5.6.2015 are made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when required to do so and abide by all the conditions laid down under Section 438(2), Cr.P.C.
