The petitioner is alleged to have induced the complainant Davinder Singh and others to part with money to send them abroad. Statements of the material witnesses stand already recorded. The petitioner has been in custody w.e.f., 21.3.2014.

This is the 4th petition filed by the petitioner for grant of regular bail. While disposing of eariler similar application on 2.3.2015, it was ordered that in case the complainant is not produced by the prosecution agency by 6.4.2015, the trial Court shall release the petitioner on bail on his furnishing bail bail/surety bond on behalf of the petitioner.

Taking into consideration, the period spent by the petitioner and the status of the trial, the petitioner can be granted the concession of bail especially when there is no other criminal case against the petitioner.

The petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
