Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of directions to official respondents to protect his life and liberty from the hands of private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that father in law of the petitioner during his life time partitioned the property between his sons vide partition deed (P1) but after his death the private respondents raised a dispute regarding partition of the property and started threatening the petitioner and her husband with dire consequences. They also gave beatings to the husband of the petitioner on 28.5.2015. Petitioner has reasonable apprehension at the hands of private respondents, who were disputing the partition deed.

Precisely, for the grievance made in the present petition, petitioner has already filed a representation (Annexure P-3) before Superintendent of Police, Jind-respondent No.2, but no action has been taken so far.

Accordingly, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, Superintendent of Police, Jind-respondent No.2 is directed to look into the representation made by the petitioner (Annexure P-3) and if required, necessary protection be provided to him if he is not required in any unlawful activity.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.
