MAHESH GROVER, J.

The petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in terms of Section 438 Cr.P.C in case FIR no. 29 dated 17.4.2015 registered under Sections 326, 324, 323, 452, 506, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Mehta, Amritsar (Rural)

The petitioners are attributed two injuries allegedly with a stick. Both the injuries are found simple in nature. This Court after considering these facts, granted interim protection to the petitioners on 5.6.2015, subject to the condition that the petitioners join the investigation.

Pursuant to the aforesaid, petitioners have joined the investigation to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer which fact is not controverted by the learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Davinder Singh.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case but noticing the fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer, instant petition is accepted. Interim directions dated 5.6.2015 are hereby made absolute, however subject to the condition that the petitioners continue to comply with the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
