By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in a case FIR No.53 dated 02.04.2015, registered under Sections 498-A, 406 IPC at Police Station Mandi Gobindgarh, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

The learned counsel for the parties state that there are chances of amicable settlement between the parties.

In view of the statement made, the parties shall approach to the trial Court for referring the matter to Mediation and Conciliation Centre of the trial Court, within three weeks from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 05.06.2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The present petition is allowed.
