This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.420 dated 28.12.2013, registered under Sections 420 IPC at Police Station Sector 26, Chandigarh, on the basis of compromise.

Vide order dated May 29, 2014, this court had directed the petitioner to appear before the trial court to record their statements. Trial court was also directed to send a report. Parties failed to appear. Another opportunity was granted vide order dated October 16, 2014. Following report has been received from the court of Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Chandigarh:-

“It is respectfully submitted that despite repeated calls given in the case on 21.1.2015 neither the petitioner nor respondent No.4 has come present on 21.1.2015. Thereafter, the case was adjourned to 27.2.2015 i.e. for today for awaiting presence of the petitioner and respondent No.4. But today again none appeared on behalf of either of the parties. Now the case has been adjourned for 31.3.2015 for awaiting further orders from the Hon'ble High Court.”

In view of above, there is no ground for quashing of FIR. This petition is hereby dismissed.
