Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.30 dated 21.04.2015, registered at Police Station Sadar Abohar, District Fazilka, under Sections 420, 406, 506, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code and 27/54/59 of Arms Act.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

There are serious allegations against the petitioner that he in connivance with co-accused has played fraud upon the complainant to the tune of more than ₹9 lacs on the pretext of providing gold ornaments

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which were required for the marriage of daughter of the complainant. To blow the lid off alleged fraud, custodial interrogation of the petitioner is required.

No ground for anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made out.
