Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined investigation.

However, State counsel submits that the petitioner along with two other persons was found in car No. HR-16-B-8801. He had, however, run away and despite chase he could not be apprehended. Balwinder Singh was caught at the spot who got regular bail after about three months of his arrest. The third person Satguru is still absconding.

In view of the facts brought before the Court by the State counsel, it is felt that grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner shall not be in the interest of justice, especially when he had run away from the spot and presented himself before the police only when he got interim relief from another Bench of this Court. Grant of anticipatory bail in such cases will send a wrong message to the society.

Dismissed.
