The petitioner prays for adequate protection on account of fact that the private respondents are threatening to take possession. I am of the view that the petitioner has adequate remedies in law in case his possession is threatened, he has remedy of filing civil suit. It has been disclosed to this Court that civil suit has been filed. He will thus have ample remedy before the civil court itself. In so far as threat to his life and liberty is concerned, the petitioner is at liberty to file complaint before the Magistrate under Section 156 Cr.P.C.
