This petition is filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 [for short 'the Cr.P.C.] for regular bail in a case FIR No.127 dated 30.7.2010 registered under Sections 21, 61 & 85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 [for short 'the NDPS Act'] at Police Station Sultanwind, District Amritsar.

The petitioner has been named by Pal Singh (PW2) and Simardeep Singh (PW3) that the car in which they had been carrying contraband was owned by the petitioner but the case of the petitioner is that the car is owned by M/s Babu Ram Kidar Nath of Lajpat Rai Road, Jagraon as per the Registration Certificate appended to the petition as Annexure P-2. Even the said witnesses namely, PW2 and PW3 have turned hostile in regard to the participation of the petitioner in the alleged offence. The petitioner is in custody since 28.11.2013.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties but without making any observations on merits, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate, Amritsar.
