The petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.164 dated 06.10.2014 registered under Sections 406, 498-A and 323 IPC at Police Station City Batala Police, District Batala.

The petitioners are relations of husband of the complainant. It is stated that the petitioners are living separately and have nothing to do with the marital affairs of the complainant and her husband.

Vide order dated 21.01.2015, this Court had granted interim bail to the petitioners while referring the matter to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

The settlement has not been arrived at between the parties. It is not in dispute that the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Considering the aforesaid facts and noticing that the petitioner are relations of husband of the complainant and are living separately and the fact that they have joined the investigation, the instant petition is allowed. The interim orders dated 21.01.2015 are

hereby made absolute subject to condition that the petitioners would continue to comply with the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The present petition stands disposed of.
