Reply filed by the State is taken on record.

Learned State counsel states that that the protection has already been provided to the present petitioner. The attention of the Court has also been drawn to the order dated 25.9.2014 passed in CRM M 16232 of 2014 titled Asha Rani v. State of Punjab and others, in which, mother of the petitioner and his family members were provided necessary security. The petitioner is the son of Asha Rani. It is stated that necessary security has been provided.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further states that the petitioner is receiving threats from the respondents to compromise the matter otherwise he will be implicated in false case under Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985. If any such

threat is received, the petitioner shall be at liberty to lodge a complaint to the concerned police station on which the police shall take action accordingly.

With aforesaid observations, the petition stands disposed of.
