The order dated 12.05.2015, passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Rupnagar shows that the application filed by the petitioner for grant of anticipatory bail was not disposed of on merits. None was present on behalf of the petitioner before the learned Additional Sessions Judge. The same was dismissed by observing by learned Additional Sessions Judge that it seems that accused is not interested in proceeding with the application. Virtually it is not a decision on merits.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the present petition may be dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to move the fresh application for grant of anticipatory bail before the Sessions Court at Rupnagar.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
