This petition has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.65 dated 18.04.2015 registered at Police Station Guruhar Sahai, District Ferozepur for offences punishable under Section 61 the Punjab Excise Act, 1914.

Heard.

As per the allegation in the FIR the police party headed by Head Constable Balvir Singh of Police Station Guruhar Sahai, on receipt of secret information, conducted a raid, the petitioner who was in a Mahindra Jeep without registration number, ran away from the spot on seeing the police party. From the jeep two cans of plastic containing sixty bottles each, were recovered.

Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for further custodial interrogation.

Keeping in view the above facts and submissions made by learned State counsel, but without commenting anything on merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The interim order dated 08.06.2015 is made absolute, on the terms mentioned therein, till the presentation of challan.
