This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 23 dated 29.04.2015, registered at Police Station Sadiq, District Faridkot, under Sections 363/366(A) of the Indian Penal Code.

The contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that the girl Sarabjit Kaur alleged to have been kidnapped is major.

On the other side, learned State counsel states that date of birth of Sarabjit Kaur is 07.01.1998 and she is below 18 years of age. Photocopy of birth certificate of Sarabjit Kaur, issued by Chief Registrar, Births and Deaths, Punjab, produced by the learned State counsel, is taken on record.

In view of the age of the girl, no ground for grant of concession of pre-arrest bail is made out.
