Petitioners, being parents-in-law of the complainant, are seeking pre-arrest bail in FIR No.40 dated 14.3.2015 registered under Sections 324, 323, 148 and 149 IPC and Sections 498-A and 406 IPC (added later on in Rapat No. 16 dated 22.4.2015) IPC at Police Station Kulgarhi, District Ferozepur.

Notice of motion was issued and interim protection was granted to the petitioners.

On two dates, i.e.16.7.2015 and 30.7.2015, Mr.Kamal Narula, Advocate, appeared on behalf of the complainant. However, today neither anybody has come present on behalf of the complainant nor any request for pass over has been made.

Learned counsel for the State submits that in compliance of the order dated 8.6.2015 passed by this Court, petitioners have joined the investigation and are no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed. The order dated 8.6.2015 passed by this Court is hereby made absolute, however, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

Disposed of, accordingly.
