Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in criminal complaint No. 95 of 2014, dated 07.03.2014, titled as "Raj Kumar versus Ramesh etc.", under Sections 218/325/326/506/34 IPC, Police Station, Sadar Dadri, pending in the Court of Shri Jatin Gujral, Ld. Judicial Magistrate Ist Class Charkhi Dadri, District Bhiwani.
