It is the contention of the counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners apprehend threat to the life and liberty from respondents 5 to 8 and, therefore, had approached the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran-respondent No.2 by way of a representation dated 03.06.2015 (Annexure P-5) but no action thereon till date has been taken.

Counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondents 2 to 4 to consider the representation of the petitioners dated 03.06.2015 (Annexure P-5), which was addressed to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran and taken appropriate steps in accordance with law.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioners, without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with directions to Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, SHO, Police Station Sadar, District Tarn Taran and Incharge

Police Post Kang, District Tarn Taran-respondents 2 to 4 respectively, to look into the representation of the petitioners dated 03.06.2015 (Annexure P-5) and if need be, take appropriate steps in accordance with law to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners.

Copy of the order be given *dasti* to counsel for the petitioners under signatures of Bench Secretary of this Court.
