AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

It is the contention of counsel for the petitioner that primarily the ground for not entertaining the application of the petitioner with regard to permission for going abroad for her treatment was that the petitioner had not filed any documents before the Court below showing the correct medical problem, which was being faced by the petitioner, despite there being no categoric objection by the prosecution. He contends that the said documents have now been placed on record alongwith the present petition. He further states that the Court can impose heavy amount of surety to ensure the return of the petitioner to India to participate in the trial.

If that be so, let the petitioner first approach the trial Court alongwith the said documents and file an application for grant of permission to go abroad, which, if moved, shall be considered afresh by the trial Court

without being influenced by the earlier order dated 29.05.2015 (Annexure P-1) and appropriate orders be passed in accordance with law at an early date.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
