GURMIT RAM, J.

It is mentioned in the petition that petitioner has filed a suit qua the land in their possession, which was decreed in his favour by the learned lower Court vide judgment and decree dated 29.11.2014. For this reason, the private respondents No. 6 to 12 are inimical to him and his family. Then it is also mentioned in this petition that earlier his wife had filed a petition i.e. CRM-M No.12338 of 2015 for issuance of direction to respondents not to harass the petitioner. This petition was disposed of by this Court vide order dated 21.04.2015 with the direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural) to look into the representation moved by the petitioner and her husband and further to take appropriate action in

accordance with law.

Now vide the instant petition, the petitioner has sought the same very relief which was sought in the earlier petition bearing No.CRM-M No.12338 of 2015. When the relief in the earlier petition vide order dated 21.04.2015 had already been granted, then the instant petition for the same very relief cannot be entertained being not maintainable. The remedy available with the present petitioner is to approach the Court concerned for the execution of the earlier order dated 21.04.2015 and also to approach the learned lower Court concerned for the execution of the alleged judgment and decree dated 29.11.2014 stated to be passed in his favour.

In view of the above, this petition stands dismissed and disposed of accordingly.
