Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioners have approached this Court by way of instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeking direction to the respondent authorities for providing protection to the life and liberty of the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that when the genuine grievance of the petitioners was not redressed, they finally approached the Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar-respondent No.2 by moving a self-contained representation dated 30.05.2015 (Annexure P-4) but the same is still pending decision. He further submits that petitioners shall be satisfied in case respondent No.2 is directed to consider and decide the representation dated 30.05.2015 within a reasonable time.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and without expressing any opinion, lest it should prejudice the rights of either of the parties, Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar-respondent No.2 is directed to look into the matter, consider the grievance including the threat perception raised by the petitioners in their representation dated 30.05.2015 (Annexure P-4) and decide the same at an early date, by passing an appropriate order, strictly in accordance with law but in any case within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, present petition stands disposed of.
