PARAMJEET SINGH, J. (ORAL)

By this order, I intend to dispose of CRM-M-19354-2015, titled
'Sucha Ram Lambardar vs. State of Punjab' and CRM-M-19877-2015,

titled 'Jasbir Singh vs. State of Punjab', as both these petitions have been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.103 dated 02.05.2015, registered at Police Station Nakodar, District Jalandhar, under Sections 420/328/120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

There are serious allegations against the petitioners that petitioner-Jasbir Singh @ Shiri and co-accused Sukhwinder Singh @ Kulwinder Singh @ Kogi, who are real nephews of complainant-Balbir Singh, in connivance with petitioner-Sucha Ram Lambardar got executed the registered sale deed with regard to 6¼ acres of land belonging to complainant. To blow the lid off fraud allegedly played by the petitioners, their custodial interrogation is required.

No ground for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made out.

Dismissed.

It goes without saying that interim order dated 18.06.2015 passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court in CRM-M-19877-2015 stands vacated.
