Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.74 dated 14.05.2015, registered at Police Station Uchana, under Sections 406 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code.

There are serious allegations against the petitioners that they have cheated the complainant to the tune of ₹20 lacs. The property in dispute has been sold to one Rakesh son of Mewa Singh despite the fact that it has already been agreed to be sold to the complainant. It apparently appears to be a fraud played by the petitioners.

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No ground for interference is made out.
