AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner, who is stated to be 31 years of age and well educated, alleges harassment at the hands of respondents 2 to 6 on the pretext that they are forcing her to get married to a person, whom she does not want to marry because of which she has run away from her house and as of now residing with one of her uncles, where she has primarily taken refuge. Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 05.06.2015 (Annexure P-4) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala highlighting therein the difficulty, which the petitioner is facing and the imminent threat to her life and liberty from her own family members i.e. respondents 2 to 6.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala to look into the representation dated 05.06.2015 (Annexure P-4) submitted by her and take appropriate steps in accordance with law.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with directions to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala-respondent No.1 to look into the representation of the petitioner dated 05.06.2015 (Annexure P-4) and if need be, take appropriate steps in accordance with law.

Copy of the order be given *dasti* to counsel for the petitioner under signatures of Bench Secretary of this Court.
