AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASI, J. (ORAL)

It is the contention of counsel for the petitioner that life and liberty of the petitioner is under threat at the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 6, against whom he has got registered an FIR No.44 dated 24.05.2015 under Sections 326, 324, 323, 34 IPC at Police Station Chohla Sahib, Tehsil and District Tarn Taran. Petitioner had approached the concerned officials but without any fruitful result. Ultimately, he has filed a representation dated 01.06.2015 (Annexure P-2) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran-respondent No.2, on which as well no further steps have been taken.

Counsel contends that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran-respondent No.2, to look into the representation dated 01.06.2015

(Annexure P-2) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner and without going into the merit of the case or commenting thereon, the present writ petition is disposed of with directions to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran-respondent No.2, to look into the representation dated 01.06.2015 (Annexure P-2) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law, if required.
