Petitioners apprehend danger to their life and liberty from respondents 4 to 8 as according to them, these respondents are against the petitioners getting married. Petitioners have already moved a representation dated 03.06.2015 (Annexure P-5) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Pathankot-respondent No.2, highlighting therein their grievance.

Counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners at this stage would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to look into the representation of the petitioners dated 03.06.2015 (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioners, without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with directions to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Pathankot-respondent No.2 to look into the representation of the petitioners dated 03.06.2015 (Annexure P-5) and if need be, take appropriate steps in accordance with law.
