SABINA, J

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.96 dated 10.04.2015, under Sections 323, 341, 506, 379, 148, 149 and 379-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Division No.5, District Ludhiana.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 15.07.2015:-

“Counsel would inter alia contend that the injury attributed to the present petitioner and on the person of Vijay Kumar/complainant has been opined to be simple in nature. Towards such assertion, counsel has adverted to the medico legal report of injured/Vijay Kumar and placed on record at Annexure P-3.

Notice of motion, returnable 16.11.2015.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be

released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and he shall remain bound by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C."

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Head Constable Swaran Singh has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted to the petitioner by this Court vide order dated 15.07.2015, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
