Prayer in the present petition is for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioners in FIR No. 81 dated 11.5.2015 registered under Sections 147, 148, 323, 452, 149 IPC at Police Station Baund Kalan, District Bhiwani.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners and the complainant are of the same village. The fight had taken place on account of some dispute regarding *dol*. It was a free fight in which persons of both sides suffered injuries. The injuries suffered by Rajender were found to be simple in nature.

Learned counsel for the State did not dispute the fact that the injuries suffered by Rajender were simple in nature, however, he submitted that for the conduct of the petitioners, they do not deserve the concession of pre-arrest bail.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and considering the fact that it was a free fight on account of some dispute regarding *dol*, in which both the parties suffered injuries, the parties are residents of the same village and the injuries suffered by the complainant were found to be simple in nature, in my opinion, the petitioners deserve concession of pre-arrest bail. Accordingly, it is directed that in case of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on furnishing of bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting/ Investigating Officer. They shall appear before the Investigating Officer as and when called upon for further investigation. They shall also be bound by all the conditions as contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
