Prayer in this petition is for quashing of private complaint No.196-I dated 15.12.2011, under Sections 323, 452 and 506 read with Section 34 IPC and under Sections 3 and 4 of the Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, titled 'Ram Chander vs. Bhagwan Dass and others', pending before the Court of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Ratia, District Fatehabad.

Vide order dated 10.5.2012, learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Ratia has passed the summoning order against the petitioners

for the commission of offence punishable under Sections 323, 452 and 506 read with Section 34 IPC and under Section 3(1)(x) of the Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe (Prevention of Atrocities) Act.

Since the order dated 10.5.2012 passed by the SDJM, Ratia is subject to revision before the Sessions Court, Fatehabad, learned counsel for the petitioners does not press the petition to enable him to approach the revisionary Court and to take all the pleas before the appropriate Court at appropriate stage.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as not pressed, however with liberty to approach the revisionary Court.
