The present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (in short 'Cr.P.C.') has been preferred for quashing FIR No.44 dated 11.03.2014 registered in Police Station City Kotkapura, District Faridkot for offence punishable under Sections 379 IPC (Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 IPC added later) and Section 21 of Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act 1957.

During course of hearing, it has transpired that the present petition was filed even before investigation in the matter could be completed by the State.

In the light of the judgment passed by this Court in ***Crl. Appeal No. 28 DBA of 1991 (State of Punjab vs. Pritam Chand and others)***, decided on 25.1.2013, the petition is dismissed being pre-mature as the investigation is still in progress.
