This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in a case FIR No.883 dated 17.12.2014 registered under Sections 323, 324 read with Section 34 IPC and Section 326 IPC (added subsequently) at Police Station City Ballabgarh, District Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was on bail but subsequently in view of addition of Section 326 IPC he was arrested and has been behind the bars since 23.12.2014 and his co-accused Sri Chand and Sunil have already been granted bail on 02.01.2015.

Be that as it may, petitioner is behind the bars since 23.12.2014 and his co-accused had already been released on bail, taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case and the fact that trial would not be concluded in near future, petitioner can be granted concession of bail.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail

on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds, to the satisfaction of trial court/Duty Magistrate, Faridabad.
