Petitioners, who are stated to be major, assert that they got married on 07.06.2015 without the consent and knowledge of respondents 4 to 6. Respondents 4 to 6, who are the parents and brothers of petitioner No.1, are not agreeing to the marriage between the petitioners and, therefore, the petitioners apprehend danger to their personal liberty and lives because of which the petitioners had even approached the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur-respondent No.2 and submitted a representation on 08.06.2015 (Annexure P-5).

Counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners at this stage would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to look into the representation of the petitioners dated 08.06.2015 (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioners, without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with directions to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur-respondent No.2 to look into the representation of the petitioners dated 08.06.2015 (Annexure P-5) and if need be, take appropriate steps in accordance with law.
