AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

It is the contention of the counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners have married each other on 07.06.2015. They both are majors and have got married without the consent of respondents 4 to 7, who are the parents and brothers of petitioner No.1. Counsel contends that the life and liberty of the petitioners is at danger from the private respondents and, therefore, they had approached the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar by way of a representation on 08.06.2015 (Annexure P-5).

She contends that the petitioners at this stage would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, District Amritsar to look into the matter and take appropriate steps in accordance with law so that the life and liberty of the petitioners are not adversely affected at the hands of respondents 4 to 7.

At this stage, Mr. Jitender Singh Dadwal, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of Satnam Singh-Respondent No.4 (father of petitioner No.1) and states that F.I.R. No.155 dated 07.06.2015 under Sections 363, 366, 380 and 120-B IPC has been registered against petitioner No.2 at Police

Station Jandiala Guru, District Amritsar (Rural). He contends that because of the registration of the F.I.R., petitioner No.2 is required in the said case.

Be that as it may, petitioner No.2 may avail of the remedy in accordance with law as regards the F.I.R., which is stated to be registered against him.

Keeping in view the submissions made by counsel for the petitioners, without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed by directing the Commissioner of Police, District Amritsar-respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation of the petitioners dated 08.06.2015 (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law.
