FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

Report dated 07.03.2015 sent by learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Samana has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Pritpal Singh, Kulbir Singh and Nishan Singh as well as of complainant Gurjeet Singh it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Learned State counsel has placed on record report of the Station House Officer, Patran, whereby, it has been informed that accused Amandeep Singh has since died.

Keeping in view that accused Amandeep Singh has died and that parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and to bring about harmonious atmosphere and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007**

(3) RCR Criminal 1052, FIR No.204 dated 17.09.2010 under Sections 419,420,467,468,471 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station, Patran, District Patiala and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
