On the own showing of the petitioner, he had been married to another person before the alleged second marriage with the complainant-Shakshi. It appears that he also has a child through the first wife. The complaint makes out clearly that even apart from the allegation of fraud, an offence under Prevention of Bigamy Act 1952 is made out. I do not think the petitioner shall have any benefit of protection by an anticipatory bail. Accordingly, the petition is dismissed.
