AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (Oral):

Petitioners apprehend danger to the life and liberty from respondents 4 and 5, who are the parents of petitioner No.1 and respondent No.6, who is her brother because of the fact that they had married without their consent and against their wishes. Petitioners have approached the Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda-respondent No.2 by way of representation dated 06.06.2015 (Annexure P-5) praying for the grant of protection of their life and liberty.

Counsel contends that the petitioners, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda-respondent No.2 to consider and take appropriate action on their representation dated 06.06.2015 (Annexure P-5), in accordance with law.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioners, without going into merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with directions to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda-respondent No.2 to look into the representation dated 06.06.2015 (Annexure P-5) and if need be, take appropriate steps, in accordance with law.
