Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for giving directions to the respondents No.1 to 3 to complete the investigation and to submit the final report in case F.I.R. No.281 dated 15.10.2013 under Sections 148, 149, 379, 447, 511, 436, 427, 506 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Madhuban, District Karnal (Annexure P-1).

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jasvinder Singh, as well as on the basis of status report filed by way of affidavit of Rajesh Kumar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police (HQ), Karnal dated

1.7.2015, submits that after registration of the case, investigation was carried out by the investigating officer, who during the course of investigation recorded the statement of witnesses and taken into the possession the relevant record. He further submits that the police has presented the challan against 10 accused whereas 16 persons were found innocent and for the remaining accused, the matter is under investigation.

The relevant part of the status-report dated 1.7.2015 is being reproduced as under:

“That after registration of the case, investigation was carried out by the Investigating Officer, who during the course of investigation recorded the statement of witnesses and taken into the possession the relevant record pertaining to the titled FIR. It is further submitted that during the course of investigation the accused Jai Singh/respondent No.4, Ilma (respondent No.13), Sandeep (respondent No.22), Harpal (respondent No.26), Babli (respondent No.35), Raju (respondent No.37), Rajinder (respondent No.45), Ram Niwas (respondent No.48), J.P. Sekhpura (respondent No.58) were arrested on 08.11.2013. However, it is further submitted that remaining accused persons named in the FIR has not been arrested till today. It is again further submitted that supplementary challan against the accused persons is be filed before the Ld. trial court as soon as investigation will be completed. It is further submitted that on 30.09.2014, supplementary Challan under section 173(8) Cr.P.C. was submitted against Hawa Singh, Ram Niwas, Raju, Harpal,

Pardeep Maratha, Rajinder, Jal Singh, Illam Singh, Sandeep and Jai Parkash. Now the trial is fixed on 10.07.2015 before the Ld. trial Court of Sh. R.K. Jain, Additional Sessions Judge, Karnal for evidence of the prosecution.”

In view of the above, no further order is required to be passed in this petition.

Disposed of as such.
